

What We Believe:

We embrace the teachings and values that guide our spiritual journey, rooted in wisdom, respect, humility, honesty, truth, courage, love, and unity. These Articles of Faith reflect our commitment to living in harmony with all creation and the one Creator.

1. **Article of Faith 1:** We believe that true wisdom lies in acknowledging that all things, both seen and unseen, are created and sustained by one Creator. We commit to seeking wisdom by understanding and recognizing the Creator's role in all aspects of existence.
2. **Article of Faith 2:** We believe that respect involves honoring all things, both seen and unseen, that the one Creator creates and sustains. We commit to respecting all of creation.
3. **Article of Faith 3:** We believe that humility involves recognizing the sacred role of humanity in the creation of the earth and, therefore, valuing human life. We commit to practicing humility by honoring and valuing all human life.
4. **Article of Faith 4:** We believe that honesty involves declaring that every human being is on a sacred walk with their Creator, fashioned in the intelligence and spirit of the one Creator. Therefore, what one has attained is not another's to covet or take away. We commit to practicing honesty by respecting each person's unique journey and their rightful attainments, both spiritual and physical.
5. **Article of Faith 5:** We believe that truth involves recognizing the sacred nature of living beings of the sky, land, and seas, acknowledging that they carry an intelligence gifted to them in the degree to which they exist and have the right to their own path. We commit to acting with restraint and safeguarding the right to live for all living beings.
6. **Article of Faith 6:** We believe that courage is living your life as a spiritual being in a physical body, having a mortal experience. We commit to embracing our spiritual nature with courage as we navigate the challenges and experiences of mortal life.

7. **Article of Faith 7:** We believe that love is attained as the one Creator intended when we give kindness unconditionally at all times to all things, both seen and unseen. We commit to practicing unconditional kindness as a manifestation of true love.
8. **Article of Faith 8:** We believe that the one Creator is a unified godhead consisting of Great Teaching Beings: an Eternal Father, an Eternal Mother, and their first and only creation, or begotten, a Great Spirit. This Great Spirit, with the assistance of the Eternal Father and Mother, created all additional spirit beings and their spiritual and physical creations. We affirm that the Great Spirit walked the earth in physical form, known by many names, as there are many languages, but collectively as the Great Peacemaker, whom we recognize as the same being known today as Jesus Christ. We commit to honoring the teachings and unity of these divine beings in our spiritual journey.
9. **Article of Faith 9:** We believe that just as the spirit is baptized into the earth through the sacred waters of the mother's womb, all flesh must be baptized through immersion into the sacred waters of Mother Earth. We commit to honoring this sacred rite as a symbol of spiritual renewal and connection with the earth and the one Creator.
10. **Article of Faith 10:** We believe in the sacred gathering of all people and the restoration of harmony among all tribes. We envision Zion, a city of peace for all living beings, being established upon the American continent, where the one Creator known as the Great Spirit who walked in the flesh as the Great Peacemaker, even Jesus Christ, will reign personally upon the earth. We affirm that the earth will be renewed to its perfect state. We commit to working towards unity and renewal, embracing the promise of a harmonious future.
11. **Article of Faith 11:** We uphold the right to worship the one Creator according to the guidance of our own conscience. We extend this same right to all people, respecting their freedom to worship in their own way, wherever and however they choose.
12. **Article of Faith 12:** We believe in prioritizing our allegiance to the one Creator above all earthly authorities, including kings, presidents, rulers, and magistrates. We commit to obeying, honoring, and sustaining the law, provided it aligns with the teachings and principles established by the one

Creator through authorized teachers.

13. **Article of Faith 13:** We believe in all records that attest to the divinity of the one Creator and the reality of the Great Peacemaker, even if known by different names in various languages. We affirm the truthfulness of the Nephite Record, the Torah—both oral and written—and the teachings of Jesus Christ as contained in the New Testament. We do not affirm the European Monarch version of the Torah, referred to as the Old Testament, and therefore do not accept it as truth.
